





Due to the existing state and national emergency and concerns regarding the Coronavirus (COVID-19) Health Crisis, the Geauga County Court of Common Pleas is taking the following actions regarding Civil Warrants and Jury Trials:

1. The Geauga County Common Pleas Court hereby orders that the Geauga County Sheriff shall not be required to take parties into custody on civil warrants issued by the Geauga County Court of Common Pleas, General Division, unless the Judge on a specific case issues an Order superseding this Order.
2. All Civil and Criminal Jury Trials through May 1, 2020, are hereby postponed and will be rescheduled at a later date.
