Based on the emergency declarations by federal, state, and local authorities, the Domestic Relations Division of the Lucas County Court of Common Pleas enters the following orders:


1. ALL HEARINGS, including complaints for divorce, petitions for dissolution, motion hearings, pre-trials, other conferences or court appearances, and court counseling appointments are STAYED until May 29, 2020 unless extended by further order of this court.
2. New petitions for DOMESTIC VIOLENCE PROTECTION ORDERS will be accepted and heard Monday through Friday, between 8:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.
3. Persons having a scheduled court appearance between the date of filing of this Order and May 29, 2020 are hereby ordered NOT TO APPEAR.
4. All hearings in the above-mentioned timeframe are continued. Court personnel will contact parties and/or attorneys with a new date for telephone or videoconference hearings or pre-trials. You will be given instructions then. Please, do not call the court concerning a new hearing date.
5. The court continues to explore alternate hearing and appearance methods with the resources available.
