
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

IT APPEARING TO THE COURT that it journalized an Entry and Order on April 6, 2020, suspending all jury trials until 11:59 p.m. on May 15, 2020, for the reasons stated therein; and

IT FURTHER APPEARING TO THE COURT that Amy Acton, MD, Ohio Director of Health, issued an Order on April 30, 2020, extending her previous order of April 2, 2020, directing all persons to continue to stay at home or their place of residence unless they are engaged in Essential Activities, Essential Governmental Functions, or to operate Essential Businesses and Operations, until 11:59 p.m. on May 29, 2020, unless the Order is rescinded or modified at a sooner time and date; and

UPON DUE CONSIDERATION OF THE FOREGOING, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, by unanimous consent of the eleven judges of the Montgomery County Court of Common Pleas, General Division, that its Order of April 6, 2020, suspending all jury trials, is continued in full force and effect until 11:59 p.m. on May 31, 2020, unless this Order is rescinded or modified at a sooner time and date.
