

Coronavirus Court Protocols ) SPECIAL COURT PROTOCOLS

In furtherance of this Court's Special Court Protocols Order of March 16, 2020, and subsequent to the Trumbull County Commissioners' Notice closing most all County Office of this date due to the discovery of a County Maintenance employee displaying symptoms consistent with the Coronavirus, this Court finds it appropriate to:

release all Court employees, retaining only a minimum staff sufficient to address any essential or time-sensitive functions, currently the chief clerk, a security officer and the judge; and


to continue all arraignments and other cases scheduled to come on before the court on March 27, 2020.

To the extent possible, the clerk will attempt to notify the necessary parties of the continuance of their cases. Otherwise, the security officer will notify those parties when they arrive at the court.

Likewise, the security officer will, until further notice, intercede with all parties attempting to enter the court and inquire as to their purpose. Excepting only in the most essential of cases, the security officer will inform those parties that the court was limiting its services to essential and time-sensitive matters. If the security officer is in doubt as to whether any party's purpose fits within such categories, he shall consult with the clerk or the judge.

This order remains in effect until further order.
