The Presiding Judge of the Perrysburg Municipal Court, Wood County, Ohio, makes the following Orders in alignment with the on-going response to the COVID-19 Public Health Crisis and in accordance with Administrative Order No. 2020-04. Temporary Orders are as follows:

- 1. Continuing Operations** - All felony and in-custody cases will continue as scheduled.
- 2. Traffic (TRD) Cases** - Effective Wednesday, March 25, 2020, all traffic cases will be cancelled and rescheduled after May 17, 2020. This includes all arraignment hearings, pre-trial conferences, plea hearings, motion hearings and all trials on all traffic designated (TRD) cases. Traffic probation violation hearings will be cancelled and rescheduled.
- 3. O.V.I. (TRC) Cases** - Effective Wednesday, March 25, 2020, all O.V.I. designated (TRC) cases, with the exception of arraignment hearings, will be cancelled and rescheduled. O.V.I. designated (TRC) probation violation hearings will be cancelled and rescheduled.
- 4. Jury Trial(s)** - No Jury Trial will take place until after May 17, 2020.

**5. Criminal Cases (Misdemeanor)** – Effective Wednesday, March 25, 2020, all non-violent misdemeanor criminal cases scheduled through May 15, 2020, will be cancelled and rescheduled. The following case type(s) will proceed as scheduled:

**a.** Domestic Violence, Assault, Child Endangering, Child Enticement, Aggravated Menacing, Unlawful Restraint, Menacing, Menacing by Stalking, Violation of Protection Order, Telephone Harassment, Vehicular Homicide and any attempt, complicity or conspiracy to commit any of the aforementioned offenses.

**b.** Any Sexually-Oriented Offenses, including Attempted Importuning, Sexual Imposition, Unlawful Sexual Conduct with a Minor, Voyeurism, Attempted Illegal Use of Minor in Nudity-Oriented Material or Performance, Attempted Child Enticement with Sexual Motivation, Unlawful Restraint with Sexual Motivation and any attempt, complicity or conspiracy to commit any of the aforementioned offenses.

**6. Probation Supervision Reporting** - All probation supervision reporting shall take place via telephone unless specifically ordered by the Probation Department or the Court.
