
This cause originated in this court on the filing of a complaint for writs of mandamus and prohibition.

Upon consideration of respondent City of Monroe Department of Public Services' concurrence in relief sought by federal notice of lack of subject matter jurisdiction and pattern of vexatious litigation, it is ordered by the court that the request to declare Joseph Emerson a vexatious litigator is granted and Joseph Emerson is found to be a vexatious litigator under S.Ct.Prac.R. 4.03(B). Accordingly, it is ordered that Joseph Emerson is prohibited from continuing or instituting legal proceedings in this court without first obtaining leave. Any request for leave shall be submitted to the clerk of this court by delivery service, by mail addressed to the Clerk of the Supreme Court, or in person for the court's review.

Upon consideration of respondents' motions to dismiss, it is ordered by the court that the motions to dismiss are granted. It is further ordered, sua sponte, that this cause is dismissed as to all remaining respondents.

It is further ordered by the court that relator's objection Sharon Kennedys 4 letters is denied as moot.

Accordingly, this cause is dismissed.
